Peak Downs Mine is a large open cut coal mine in Queensland, located 31km SSE of Moranbah. Peak DOwns is one of seven mines in the Bowen Basin owned by BHP Mitsubishi Alliance, Australia's largest coal miner and exporter.

Scope of Work

Electrical fire suppression and lid for electrical drawer containment and positive pressure dust suppresion. Lift installed on coal minesite in Queensland. The original filters selected were not suitable for the harsh environment, though this was swiftly changed by the CP group to match the conditions.
